BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT



Southern Area Hospice Services offer bereavement support to anyone with a palliative diagnosis/condition, or any family member or carer bereaved due to a palliative illness living in the Southern Trust area. These services are:

Bereavement monthly drop in group

These group sessions aim to help make the bereavement journey less painful by sharing thoughts, feelings, and helping participants understand the bereavement process.

Bereavement walking group

Join our Chaplains and Social Workers for a guided, friendly group walk where you can stroll at your own pace and chat to others who have been bereaved. These walks are a great opportunity to get out and enjoy the fresh air. The walking groups rotate between Dungannon and Newry.

Complementary therapy

If you are struggling to cope with your

grief, and at times find it overwhelming, we are here to help. Complementary therapy sessions can help both emotionally and physically and provide a much needed 'time-out.

Counselling

Grief is a very difficult journey, and it is normal to struggle and experience a range of challenging emotions. Attending a counselling session with our bereavement counsellors can help.

Support for children & teenagers

Support is available for children and teenagers in the form of one-to-one counselling, and bereavement groups.
